

JACKSON COUNTY IS UNDER A LEVEL TWO DROUGHT
STATUS.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE NEW OUTDOOR WATERING
GUIDELINES BELOW:

Persistent dry weather is causing the Bear Creek Reservoir to drop on a daily basis. Until there are significant rainfall events allowing river flows to increase, the reservoir cannot be replenished. Therefore, **LEVEL TWO restrictions are in place beginning October 1st, 2011.**

No outdoor watering is permitted between the hours of 10:00 am and 4:00 pm on your designated day. Your designated day is based on your address, as set forth below:

Even numbered addresses may only water on Saturdays

Odd numbered addresses may only water on Sundays

NOTE: Any hand-held watering nozzles with the ability to shut off water flow may be used on any day of the week.

Athletic fields must abide by these restrictions. Golf courses must abide by these restrictions but may water their tee boxes and greens as necessary.
