

Jackson County Water and Sewerage Authority Irrigation Meter Policy

On July 13th, 2006, the board of the Jackson County Water and Sewerage Authority adopted an irrigation meter policy to provide uniformity in installation and metering of irrigation water in sewerred subdivisions.

1.

All owners/developers of *proposed* subdivisions where the Jackson County Water and Sewerage Authority shall be the provider for sewerage service shall be required to submit, with the Authority's "Preliminary Application", their intention as to whether they intend to install separate irrigation meters for the individual lots within said subdivision. If no irrigation meters are elected to be installed with the project, the Authority shall not be obligated to install irrigation meters for any individual lot or lots. If a request is made to the Authority by the owner of any lot or lots to install an irrigation meter, the lot owner shall make payment to the Authority for all associated installation costs including the water connection fee at the rate in effect at the time the request is made. Additionally, the lot owner shall be required to sign a "damage waiver" form supplied by the Authority.

2.

In all *existing* sewerred subdivisions containing lots without irrigation meters, a lot owner requesting an irrigation meter shall make payment to the Authority for all associated installation costs including the water connection fee at the rate in effect at the time the request is made. Additionally, the lot owner shall be required to sign a "damage waiver" form supplied by the Authority.

3.

Effective immediately, all Authority customers with an irrigation meter shall pay a minimum monthly fee of \$5.00 to cover billing and maintenance costs. This fee shall be in addition to the monthly "per thousand gallon" usage fee.
